Scholarship Awards

Approximately \$150,000 in awards will be presented to high school and college students selected to receive scholarships in 2010. It is the largest amount in scholarships since the Foundation began its yearly awards program.

The Mendocino College Foundation contributes 80% of the total dollars awarded to students every year. In addition, local organizations, businesses, and individuals are among the other donors to scholarship funding.

Applications for awards are due annually at the beginning of March. Students need only complete one application to be eligible for scholarships presented by the College and the Foundation.
